OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment eliminates the potential loss of state aid to municipalities in the underlying bill. The amendment does so by eliminating the penalty established by the underlying bill for failing to comply with specified zoning statutes.

The amendment requires municipalities to submit to the Office of Policy and Management a statement that either 1) certifies compliance with certain zoning regulations, or 2) describes the timeline in which the municipality expects to be in compliance with such regulations. This has no fiscal impact.

The amendment makes other changes concerning the regulation of child care facilities which have no fiscal impact, as the regulations relate to private entities.
