No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the language of the underlying bill and replaces it with language that: (1) allows prophylaxis, and (2) requires physicians and advanced practice nurses providing it to minors 12 years of age or younger to report certain information to the Department of Children and Families (DCF) for the purposes of a report. It is anticipated that the number of cases of prophylaxis to minors 12 years of age or younger will be limited and that DCF can produce the required report within its existing resources.
