No Fiscal Impact

The amendment, which requires health care practitioners to notify parents/guardians if their children seek treatment/rehabilitation for substance dependence—unless such disclosure would place the minors' lives in jeopardy, is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the State or municipalities.
