## ***OFA Fiscal Note***

### ***No Fiscal Impact***

The bill requires practitioners that provide prophylaxis to minors, 12 years of age or younger, to report certain information to the Department of Children and Families (DCF) for the purposes of a report. The amendment expands this notification requirement to encompass all minors. This is not projected to result in a fiscal impact to the State or municipalities. It is anticipated that the number of prophylaxis-given-to-a-minor cases will be limited, and that DCF can produce the required report within its existing resources.
