OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment establishes a Council on the Collateral Consequences of a Criminal Record to study discrimination faced by people in Connecticut living with a criminal record.

The council shall submit a report of its findings and legislative recommendations to the Labor and Public Employees Committee by February 1, 2020.

This bill has no fiscal impact as PA 17-236 prohibits transportation allowances for council members.
