No Fiscal Impact

The amendment requires that any public employee union receiving information from a public employer about a public employee give a bond to the state with sufficient surety to provide credit monitoring and identity theft protection services to all employees whose information the union receives in the event of a data breach. This has no fiscal impact to the State or municipalities as the costs would be borne by the unions.
