Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact resulting in the following impact. The amendment allows visitors to the state with an out-of-state authorization for medical marijuana to purchase marijuana in Connecticut at a licensed dispensary resulting in no fiscal impact to the state.
