The amendment strikes the language of the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

Section 2 of the amendment requires the Departments of Children and Families (DCF) and Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) to jointly provide an annual training program for emergency mobile psychiatric services personnel and mental health crisis intervention services personnel. To the extent the agencies would require additional resources to support such trainings beyond the trainings they currently provide, the state could experience a cost. For reference, the annual cost for a similar training is approximately \$5,500. The actual cost of the amendment will depend on the training provided and the number of individuals who wish to enroll in such training.

Section 3 of the amendment is anticipated to result in a cost to the Department of Public Health to provide an annual training to emergency medical service entities and personnel. The agency does not currently provide any such trainings. Sections 1 and 4 are not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the State or municipalities.
