## ***OFA Fiscal Note***

### ***Potential Cost***

The amendment requires any convicted felon who has been discharged from the Department of Correction (DOC) to go before the Board of Pardons and Paroles (BOPP) to determine if electoral privileges will be restored and results in a potential cost to the DOC. To the extent that a significant amount of additional hearings are required, the BOPP may have to hire additional staff.
