No Fiscal Impact

The amendment is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the State or municipalities. It clarifies that, in the event of a conflict between a provision of the State Water Plan and a provision of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS), the CGS will take precedence over the State Water Plan.
