OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment eliminates the provision of the underlying bill that prohibits youths under 18 years of age from the custody of the Department of Correction (DOC), removing both the cost of \$18 million in FY 22 to the Judicial Department and savings of \$103,000 in FY 21 to DOC. In addition, the removal of section 2 through 4 makes the cost to DOC associated with the ombudsman ongoing.
