OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Cost

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment requires the registrars of voters to appoint one or more election officials, including official checkers, to serve at an Election Day Registration (EDR) location. To the extent a municipality is not currently appointing such individuals a potential cost may be incurred.

The amendment also requires the State Elections Enforcement Commission (SEEC) to conduct an investigation if the registrars of voters cannot verify the residency of an admitted applicant. Dependent on the number of investigations, SEEC may need to hire additional staff.
