No Fiscal Impact

The amendment makes various changes to law enforcement procedures, adds a reporting requirement for law enforcement, requires a preliminary status report to be completed by the Division of Criminal Justice when a person dies after use of physical force by a peace officer, creates a task force to study police transparency and accountability, and makes other changes that do not result in a fiscal impact.
