OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the language of the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. It changes the definition of sex discrimination and allows, by 7/1/20, for the sex of children to be designated as non-binary on their birth certificates, or intersex adults to amend their birth certificates to reflect that status on or after 7/1/21. Birth certificates offering a non-binary designation option have been available since January 2019. As such, there is no cost to the Department of Public Health or municipal offices of vital records anticipated from the amendment.
