The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment requires the Office of Policy and Management to study the impact on state agencies of entering into or negotiating certain types of contracts with their employees. This has no fiscal impact as it is anticipated the agency can complete the study within existing resources.
