Explanation

The amendment requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to post a sign at the high waterline where state park beaches adjoin other beaches. As it is anticipated these signs would be metal signs posted on metal poles, this is anticipated to result in a cost of up to \$20,000 in FY 20. Cardboard or paper signs would cost considerably less. The extent of costs in FY 20 depends on the number of signs posted, and the availability of federal funds or other grants that may be available for this purpose.
