Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

Instead, it results in a cost to the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) as it requires the agency to pay \$750 to each vendor of sportsmen licenses. It is uncertain in which fiscal year the payment would occur.
