OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Savings

The amendment requires the Commissioner of Children and Families to suspend, without pay, an employee within five days of the commencement of an investigation into the death or serious injury of a child due to that employee's failure to comply with CGS Sec. 17a-6 regulations or rules. This may result in a savings to the Department of Children and Families, to the extent that employees are suspended and found responsible for such failure.
