OFA Fiscal Note

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment requires the Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) to develop a model internship program in the fields of technology and advanced manufacturing for use by companies and businesses in the state. To the extent DECD uses a consultant to develop the program, there will be a cost of up to \$100,000 to meet the provisions of the amendment.

Additionally, the amendment requires DECD to analyze existing and future talent needs of the state by using an independent data provider. This is anticipated to result in a cost of up to \$50,000 for the use of data provider.

The amendment makes various other changes that do not result in a fiscal impact.

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
