The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment permits the Connecticut Green Bank to apply for certain federal funding, resulting in a potential revenue gain to the Bank to the extent they qualify and receive any additional funding. The amendment also makes technical changes to the Bank's Board, which has no fiscal impact.
