"AN ACT ENHANCING PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) For purposes of this section, (1)
4 "human services" means direct services to state residents delivered by
5 the Departments of Social Services, Developmental Services, Children
6 and Families or Mental Health and Addiction Services; and (2) "public-
7 private partnership" means the relationship established between the
8 Departments of Social Services, Developmental Services, Children and
9 Families or Mental Health and Addiction Services by contracting with
10 a private, nonprofit entity for the delivery of human services.

11 (b) There is established a public-private partnership advisory
12 council for the delivery of human services. The advisory council shall
13 consist of the following members:

14 (1) Two representatives of nonprofit human services organizations
15 appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives, both of

- 16 whom have expertise in the delivery of human services;
- 17 (2) Two appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;
- 18 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
19 Representatives;
- 20 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;
- 21 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
22 Representatives;
- 23 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;
- 24 (7) The Commissioners of Social Services, Developmental Services,
25 Children and Families and Mental Health and Addiction Services, or
26 the commissioners' designees;
- 27 (8) Two persons appointed by the Governor; and
- 28 (9) The Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, or the
29 secretary's designee.
- 30 (c) Any member of the advisory council appointed under
31 subdivision (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may
32 be a member of the General Assembly.
- 33 (d) All appointments to the advisory council shall be made not later
34 than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy
35 shall be filled by the appointing authority.
- 36 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president
37 pro tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the advisory
38 council from among the members of the advisory council. Such
39 chairpersons shall schedule the first meeting of the advisory council,
40 which shall be held not later than sixty days after the effective date of
41 this section.
- 42 (f) The administrative staff of the Commission on Women, Children

43 and Seniors shall serve as administrative staff of the advisory council.

44 (g) Not later than November 1, 2019, the advisory council shall
 45 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
 46 statutes, to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly
 47 having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the
 48 budgets of state agencies, children, human services and public health.
 49 The report shall include, but need not be limited to, recommendations
 50 concerning state-administered human services that may be directly
 51 provided by a public-private partnership on a more cost-efficient basis.
 52 Said joint standing committees shall hold a public hearing on the
 53 report not later than thirty days after receipt of the report.

54 (h) The advisory council shall terminate on January 1, 2020.

55 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioners of Social
 56 Services, Developmental Services, Children and Families and Mental
 57 Health and Addiction Services may contract for the delivery of human
 58 services through a public-private partnership recommended by the
 59 public-private partnership advisory council pursuant to section 501 of
 60 this act. The provisions of section 4e-16 of the general statutes shall not
 61 apply to any such contract."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
