"AN ACT CONCERNING TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM CONTRIBUTIONS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (26) of section 10-183b of the general statutes
4 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2019*):

6 (26) "Teacher" means (A) any teacher, permanent substitute teacher,
7 principal, assistant principal, supervisor, assistant superintendent or
8 superintendent employed by the public schools in a professional
9 capacity while possessing a certificate or permit issued by the State
10 Board of Education, provided on and after July 1, 1975, such certificate

11 shall be for the position in which the person is then employed, except
 12 as provided for in section 10-183qq, (B) certified personnel who
 13 provide health and welfare services for children in nonprofit schools,
 14 as provided in section 10-217a, under an oral or written agreement, (C)
 15 any person who is engaged in teaching or supervising schools for
 16 adults if the annual salary paid for such service is equal to or greater
 17 than the minimum salary paid for a regular, full-time teaching position
 18 in the day schools in the town where such service is rendered, (D) a
 19 member of the professional staff of the State Board of Education, the
 20 Office of Early Childhood, or of the Board of Regents for Higher
 21 Education or any of the constituent units, [and] (E) a member of the
 22 staff of the State Education Resource Center established pursuant to
 23 section 10-4q of the 2014 supplement to the general statutes, revision of
 24 1958, revised to January 1, 2013, or the State Education Resource
 25 Center established pursuant to section 10-357a, employed in a
 26 professional capacity while possessing a certificate or permit issued by
 27 the State Board of Education, and (F) any person who is employed by
 28 the Technical Education and Career System established pursuant to
 29 section 10-95 and begins state service on or after July 1, 2027. A
 30 "permanent substitute teacher" is one who serves as such for at least
 31 ten months during any school year."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
