"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STORAGE OF A PISTOL OR REVOLVER IN A MOTOR VEHICLE."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1,
4 2021, and annually thereafter, the Chief Justice of the Judicial Branch,
5 or the Chief Justice's designee, shall, within available appropriations,
6 (1) compile data concerning prosecutions under section 53a-212 of the
7 general statutes during the previous calendar year, and (2) report data
8 indicating in each such prosecution the location, whether such location
9 was a motor vehicle or dwelling and from which part of the motor
10 vehicle or dwelling such firearm was stolen, or any other location from
11 which the firearm was stolen under such prosecution, in accordance
12 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint
13 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
14 matters relating to the judiciary.

15 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Chief State's Attorney, or the
 16 Chief State's Attorney's designee, shall, within available
 17 appropriations, (1) determine how many (A) persons, during the
 18 calendar year prior to the effective date of this section, were charged
 19 with a violation of section 53a-212 of the general statutes, and (B) such
 20 persons were prosecuted under such charges and the disposition of
 21 such cases, and (2) develop recommendations to more effectively
 22 prosecute cases in which a person is charged with a violation of section
 23 53a-212 of the general statutes.

24 (b) Not later than one year following the effective date of this
 25 section, the Chief State's Attorney, or the Chief State's Attorney's
 26 designee, shall report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-
 27 4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the
 28 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the
 29 judiciary, the findings and recommendations made pursuant to
 30 subsection (a) of this section."
