**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL."**

1      Strike subsection (b) of section 1 in its entirety and insert the  
2      following in lieu thereof:

3      "(b) If the Attorney General finds that a person has committed an act  
4      that constitutes a violation of section 53a-181j, 53a-181k or 53a-181l of  
5      the general statutes, the Attorney General may bring a civil action in  
6      the superior court for the judicial district in which such act occurred in  
7      the name of the state against such person. The provisions of this  
8      subsection shall not apply to any: (1) State officer or employee who is  
9      entitled to indemnification and defense pursuant to section 5-141d of  
10     the general statutes, or (2) municipal employee entitled to  
11     indemnification and defense pursuant to section 7-465 of the general  
12     statutes."

13     Strike subsection (h) of section 2 in its entirety and insert the

14 following in lieu thereof:

15       "(h) The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to any: (1)  
16 State officer or employee who is entitled to indemnification and  
17 defense pursuant to section 5-141d of the general statutes, or (2)  
18 municipal employee entitled to indemnification and defense pursuant  
19 to section 7-465 of the general statutes."
