**"AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM FAIR WAGE."**

- 1        In line 23, strike "On October 15, 2023, and on each October"
- 2        In line 23, after "hour." insert the following:
- 3        "Effective July 1, 2023, and not later than each July fifteenth
- 4        thereafter, the Labor Commissioner shall announce an adjustment in
- 5        the minimum fair wage that shall be equal to the percentage increase
- 6        between the last complete calendar year and the previous calendar
- 7        year in the consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical
- 8        workers in the northeast urban area of New York-Newark-Jersey City,
- 9        NY-NJ-PA, with no seasonal adjustment, as calculated by the United
- 10       States Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics, with the
- 11       amount of the minimum fair wage increase rounded to the nearest five
- 12       cents. The minimum fair wage plus the adjustment announced by the
- 13       Labor Commissioner on July fifteenth shall become the new minimum
- 14       fair wage and shall be effective on the January first immediately
- 15       following."
