**"AN ACT CONCERNING ERASURE OF CERTAIN MISDEMEANOR
CRIMINAL RECORDS AND EXPEDITED PARDONS REVIEW FOR
CERTAIN FELONY OFFENSES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2019*) Any person who is
4 required under state or federal law to conduct a criminal history
5 records check of an individual and who reasonably relies on the results
6 of such records check in compliance with the applicable state or federal
7 law shall be immune from civil liability in any action relating to the
8 results of an individual whose criminal history records were checked
9 and erased under section 54-142a of the general statutes, as amended
10 by this act. As used in this section, "person" means any individual,
11 entity, organization, firm, partnership, association, limited liability
12 company or corporation, public or private, organized or existing under
13 the laws of the state or any other state."
