**"AN ACT PROTECTING EMPLOYEE FREEDOM OF SPEECH AND
CONSCIENCE."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsections (c) and (d) of section 5-164a of the general
4 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
5 (*Effective October 1, 2019*):

6 (c) No member reemployed under this section or under section 5-
7 164 or elected to serve in the General Assembly or otherwise
8 reentering state service shall receive a retirement income during such
9 member's reemployment or other state service. [except (1) if such
10 member's services as an employee are rendered for not more than one
11 hundred twenty working days in any one calendar year, provided that
12 any member reemployed for a period of more than one hundred
13 twenty working days in one calendar year shall reimburse the state
14 retirement fund for retirement income payments received during such

15 one hundred twenty working days; (2) if such member's services are as
 16 a member of the General Assembly or as a sessional employee of the
 17 General Assembly during the regular legislative session, such
 18 member's retirement income payments shall not be suspended; or (3) if
 19 such member's preretirement services which counted towards
 20 retirement are other than as a special deputy sheriff pursuant to
 21 chapter 78, and if such member's postretirement services are as a
 22 special deputy sheriff or, on and after December 1, 2000, as a judicial
 23 marshal and such member was employed as a special deputy sheriff
 24 on July 1, 1999.]

25 (d) Upon the subsequent retirement of a member who has made an
 26 election under subsection (a) of this section, or upon the expiration of
 27 the term of office of a member of the General Assembly who has made
 28 an election under subsection (b) of this section, [his] such member's
 29 retirement income shall be recomputed on the basis of [his] such
 30 member's total period of credited state service, [excluding any period
 31 for which a retirement salary was paid under subdivision (1) or (2) of
 32 subsection (c) of this section,] and with [his] such member's base salary
 33 recomputed on the basis of [his] such member's three highest-paid
 34 years of [his] such member's total state service."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
