"AN ACT PROTECTING EMPLOYEE FREEDOM OF SPEECH AND CONSCIENCE."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2019*) As used in this section,
4 "labor organization" means any organization or association or any
5 agency or employee representation committee or plan which exists for
6 the purpose, in whole or part, of dealing with employers concerning
7 grievances, labor disputes, wages, rates of pay, hours of employment
8 or conditions of work, or any federation or council located in this state
9 representing any group of such labor organizations. Each labor
10 organization that provides a contribution to a candidate committee or
11 an exploratory committee of a candidate for a federal, state or
12 municipal elected office, shall provide written notification, not less
13 than annually, to the members of such organization of the amount of a
14 member's dues that has been used to make a contribution to such
15 candidate committee or exploratory committee. Such written

16 notification shall specifically identify the name of each candidate
17 committee or exploratory committee that received such contribution
18 and the amount of a member's dues that was used to fund such
19 contribution."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Sec. 501	<i>October 1, 2019</i>	New section
