**H.B. No. 5019** (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FIVE-CENT TAX ON SINGLE-USE PLASTIC AND PAPER BAGS', to encourage consumer use of reusable bags.

**H.B. No. 5384** (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT REQUIRING THE ELIMINATION OF SINGLE-USE STYROFOAM CONTAINERS', to reduce litter in parks, waterways and urban centers and to create cost-savings in the recycling process.

**H.B. No. 7293** (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE REDEVELOPMENT OF CERTAIN SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES', to provide that the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection may issue an order requiring the execution of a contract for the redevelopment of the Connecticut Solid Waste System Project.

**H.B. No. 7294** (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING BOTTLE REDEMPTION IN THE STATE', to amend the bottle bill in order to increase handling fees, redistribute escheats from unredeemed bottles, include additional beverage containers in the redemption value requirement, encourage additional independent redemption centers, increase the redemption value of such containers and establish a goal for the recycling of such containers.

**H.B. No. 7295** (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A RECYCLING PROGRAM FOR PAPER AND PACKAGING AND REQUIRING CERTAIN MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT GOALS', to require the establishment of a producer-financed recycling program for packaging and paper in the state and to require certain solid waste reduction goals of municipalities.

**H.B. No. 7296** (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECYCLING OF GLASS', to require the development of a plan that will implement best practices for the recycling of glass in the state and to require certain glass beverage containers sold in the state to have a minimum post- consumer glass content in order to help foster a market for recycled glass.

**H.B. No. 7297** (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING QUARANTINE AND DISPOSAL ORDERS OF ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICERS', to clarify statutes concerning animal quarantine and disposal orders issued after a dog or other animal bites or attacks.

**H.B. No. 7298** (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE PERMITTING FOR CERTAIN SOLID WASTE FACILITIES AND THE DESIGNATION OF RECYCLABLE ITEMS', to (1) require final determinations on certain permits of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection within ninety days of the submission of such permit applications, including certain solid waste management facilities and publicly owned treatment works, (2) redesignate recyclable items, (3) reallocate department staff resources concerning solid waste management, and (4) revise certain reporting requirements of resources recovery facilities.
