H.B. No. 7412 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF CERTAIN TAXES', to require the Commissioner of Revenue Services to conduct a study of certain taxes.

H.B. No. 7413 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE FAILURE TO FILE FOR CERTAIN GRAND LIST EXEMPTIONS AND THE PAYMENT OF A GRANT-IN-AID TO THE TOWN OF WALLINGFORD, AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF CERTAIN TEMPORARY NOTES BY THE TOWN OF WOODBRIDGE AND CONCERNING THE EXTENSION FOR FILING A DECLARATION', to (1) allow certain persons to file for property tax exemptions, notwithstanding certain statutory deadlines, (2) require the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to pay a grant-in-aid to the town of Wallingford for extension of municipal water services, (3) authorize the town of Woodbridge to renew certain temporary notes, notwithstanding the statutory renewal period, and (4) specify that a personal property declaration filing extension request be made in writing.

H.B. No. 7414 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE STATE CAPITOL COMPLEX FUND FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURE PROGRAMS AT THE STATE CAPITOL AND THE OLD STATE HOUSE AND A TAX CREDIT FOR DONATIONS TO SAID FUND', to establish the State Capitol Complex Fund for donations to undertake capital expenditure programs at the State Capitol and the Old State House and provide a tax credit for donations to said fund.

H.B. No. 7415 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A SURCHARGE ON CAPITAL GAINS', to impose a two per cent surcharge on the net gain from the sale or exchange of capital assets for certain taxpayers.

H.B. No. 7416 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF WAYS TO ENCOURAGE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE CONNECTICUT REGIONAL MARKET IN HARTFORD', to require the Commissioner of Agriculture and the executive director of the Capital Region Development Authority to jointly study ways to encourage the renovation and expansion of the Connecticut Regional Market in Hartford.
