**S.B. No. 797** (RAISED) **COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CHILDREN'S SAFETY'**, to require the Commissioner of Children and Families to conduct a study to determine whether policy and procedural changes within the Department of Children and Families may increase the safety of children.

**S.B. No. 801** (RAISED) **VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 'AN ACT EXPANDING CERTAIN VETERANS' ACCESS TO PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS'**, to require that pension benefits granted to certain veterans by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs be disregarded when determining income eligibility for certain state Medicaid programs.

**S.B. No. 802** (RAISED) **VETERANS' AFFAIRS. 'AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISCOUNTED FISHING LICENSES FOR CERTAIN VETERANS'**, to reduce by fifty per cent the fees charged to certain disabled veterans for sport fishing licenses, permits, tags or stamps.
