S.B. No. 229 (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF STYROFOAM TRAYS IN CONNECTICUT SCHOOLS', to end the use of styrofoam trays in Connecticut schools.

S.B. No. 997 (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING DOG LICENSING FEES', to increase funds generated for the animal population control program in order to pay veterinarians for their services and to enable towns to better offset costs related to municipal animal shelters.

S.B. No. 998 (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO ENVIRONMENT RELATED STATUTES', to make minor revisions to various environment related statutes.

S.B. No. 999 (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE FEE FOR ADOPTING A DOG, CAT OR OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMAL FROM A MUNICIPAL POUND AND REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF SUCH CATS AND OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS', to increase the fee paid by anyone adopting a dog from a municipal shelter and to require the payment of such fee for anyone adopting a cat or other domestic animal from a municipal shelter and to require the licensing of such cats and other domestic animals.

S.B. No. 1000 (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING APPLE ASSESSMENTS', to require a minimum contribution by apple producers toward the apple market order.

REF. ENVIRONMENT

S.B. No. 1001 (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL OF SMOKE DETECTORS', to require an assessment of the need to implement an extended producer responsibility program for residential smoke detectors.

S.B. No. 1002 (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING PHOSPHATE BYWASTES FROM ANAEROBIC DIGESTERS', to provide incentive for the use of technology by operators of anaerobic digesters that enables the conversion of phosphate rich bywastes into a useful commercial product.
