S.B. No. 344 (COMM) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT PROMOTING DIVERSITY IN THE SELECTION OF A JURY PANEL', to promote racial and ethnic diversity in the selection of a jury panel.

REF. JUDICIARY

S.B. No. 761 (COMM) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT PROMOTING THE USE OF HONEST RECOMMENDATIONS BETWEEN EMPLOYERS AND PROHIBITING AN EMPLOYER'S USE OF A NONDISCLOSURE AGREEMENT RELATING TO ACTS OF DISCRIMINATION OCCURRING IN THE EMPLOYER'S WORKPLACE', to: (1) Require an employer to provide honest recommendations and commenting to a prospective employer about any act of sexual harassment or sexual assault by a current or former employer, and (2) prohibit employers from requiring an employee to enter into a contract that prevents the employee from disclosing discrimination that occurs in the workplace.

REF. JUDICIARY

S.B. No. 792 (COMM) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CREATING AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO STUDY DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF GENDER IDENTITY OR EXPRESSION THAT OCCURS IN WORKPLACES AND SCHOOLS IN THE STATE', to establish an advisory committee that shall examine how state laws may be enhanced in order to strengthen protections against discrimination on the basis of gender identity or expression that occurs in workplaces and schools.

S.B. No. 1083 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT IMPROVING THE INTEGRITY OF THE CONNECTICUT BUSINESS REGISTRY', to make various statutory revisions suggested by the Secretary of the State that will allow the Office of the Secretary of the State to improve the integrity of the state's business registry.

REF. JUDICIARY

S.B. No. 1084 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING SHORT-TERM HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS AND THE AUTHORITY OF THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER TO IMPOSE FINES AGAINST AN INSURER OR HEALTH CARE CENTER', to extend the duration of short-term health insurance policies and permit the Insurance Commissioner to impose a fine against an insurer or health care center that violates a statutory provision relating to such policies.

REF. JUDICIARY

S.B. No. 1085 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEGALIZATION OF THE RETAIL SALE AND POSSESSION OF CANNABIS AND CONCERNING ERASURE OF CRIMINAL RECORDS IN THE CASE OF CONVICTIONS BASED ON THE POSSESSION OF A SMALL AMOUNT OF CANNABIS', to legalize and regulate the recreational use of cannabis and to allow for erasure of criminal records for convictions based on the possession of small amounts of cannabis.

S.B. No. 1086 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REPEAT DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OFFENDERS', to increase penalties imposed upon persons for repeat offenses of driving under the influence of intoxicating drugs or liquor.

REF. JUDICIARY

S.B. No. 1087 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING SERVICE OF PROCESS ON OUT-OF-STATE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES AND REGISTERED FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES', to permit additional methods for service of process on out-of-state financial institutions, limited liability companies and registered foreign limited liability companies.

REF. JUDICIARY

S.B. No. 1088 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF A NURSING HOME RESIDENT AS THE RESULT OF A RECEIVERSHIP PROCEEDING', to ensure the health and well-being of a nursing home resident who is at risk of being involuntarily transferred from one facility to another as the result of a receivership proceeding.

REF. JUDICIARY

S.B. No. 1089 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CANNABIS AND THE WORKPLACE', to provide that no employer is required to make accommodations for or allow employees to use or possess cannabis in the workplace.
