**AN ACT CONCERNING A PLAN TO PARTNER WITH
MANUFACTURERS TO PROVIDE EQUIPMENT TO SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) On or before January 1, 2021, the
2 Commissioner of Economic and Community Development shall
3 develop a plan to partner with the state's manufacturing community to
4 provide equipment to schools for the purpose of training students in the
5 operation of such equipment and developing the skills necessary to
6 enter the manufacturing workforce. Not later than January 1, 2021, the
7 commissioner shall submit, in accordance with the provisions of section
8 11-4a of the general statutes, such plan to the joint standing committee
9 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
10 commerce.
