"AN ACT CONCERNING ABSENTEE VOTING AND REPORTING OF RESULTS AT THE 2020 STATE ELECTION AND ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (l) of section 9-140 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (l) (1) No candidate, party or political committee, or agent of such
7 candidate or committee shall mail unsolicited applications for absentee
8 ballots to any person, unless such mailing includes: [(1)] (A) A written

9 explanation of the eligibility requirements for voting by absentee ballot
 10 as prescribed in subsection (a) of section 9-135, and [(2)] (B) a written
 11 warning that voting or attempting to vote by absentee ballot without
 12 meeting one or more of such eligibility requirements subjects the elector
 13 or applicant to potential civil and criminal penalties. As used in this
 14 [subsection] subdivision, "agent" means any person authorized to act on
 15 behalf of another person.

16 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of this
 17 subsection, the Secretary of the State shall not mail unsolicited
 18 applications for absentee ballots to any person."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
