- 8 ballots to any person, unless such mailing includes: [(1)] (A) A written

9 explanation of the eligibility requirements for voting by absentee ballot

- as prescribed in subsection (a) of section 9-135, and [(2)] (B) a written
- warning that voting or attempting to vote by absentee ballot without
- meeting one or more of such eligibility requirements subjects the elector
- or applicant to potential civil and criminal penalties. As used in this
- 14 [subsection] <u>subdivision</u>, "agent" means any person authorized to act on
- 15 behalf of another person.
- 16 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of this
- 17 <u>subsection</u>, the Secretary of the State shall not mail unsolicited
- 18 applications for absentee ballots to any person."
