**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION BY THE CONNECTICUT AIRPORT AUTHORITY UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, SECURITY SERVICES AT BRADLEY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND A STUDY OF STRUCTURES TO BE ERECTED PROXIMATE TO GENERAL AVIATION AIRPORTS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To: (1) Allow the executive director of the Connecticut Airport Authority to determine whether there are reasonable grounds to believe the disclosure of records concerning the security infrastructure at Connecticut Airport Authority airports may result in a safety risk, (2) require the Connecticut Airport Authority and the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection to enter into a contract for security services at Bradley International Airport, and (3) repeal a requirement for the Connecticut Airport Authority to study certain safety hazards.
