MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, March 5, 2020

12:30 PM in Room 2B of the LOB

The meeting was called to order at 12:34p.m. by Chairman, Sen. Anwar S. S03.

The meeting was immediately recessed for caucus then reconvened at 1:30p.m. by Chairman, Sen. Anwar S. S03.

Sen. Anwar S. S03 announced that the voting will be open until 4:00p.m.

Motion to JFS SB 105 was made by Rep. Rose K. 118 and seconded by Rep. Butler L. 072. After discussion the chair asked for a roll call voted and the bill passed 7 to 5.

Motion to JF SB 108 was made by Rep. Butler L. 072 and seconded by Rep. McGee B. 005. During discussion, it was clarified that this bill creates 20 new vouchers. The Chair then asked for a roll call vote and the bill passed 11 to 1.

Motion to JF on SB 109 was made by Rep Butler L. 072 and seconded by Rep. McGee B. 005. During discussion, Rep. Zullo J. 099 offered an amendment, but after

clarification from the chairs, retracted it. The chair then asked for a roll call vote and the bill was passed 8 to 4.

Motion to JF SB 110 was made by Rep. Butler L. 072 and seconded by Rep. McGee B. 005. There was discussion, and a motion to vote on Amendment A made by Rep. Zullo J. 099 and seconded by Rep. Smith R. 108. Discussion was held on the amendment and then voted on by roll call vote and was failed 4 to 6. The chair then asked for a roll call vote on the original bill which was passed by a vote of 8 to 5.

Motion to JFS SB 184 was made by Rep. McGee B. 005 and seconded by Rep. Butler L. 072. After discussion the chair asked for a roll call vote which passed 13 to 0

Motion to JF HB 5123 was made by Rep. McGee B. 005 and seconded by Rep. Rose K. 118. Discussion was heard on the bill and a motion to vote on Amendment A made by Rep. Zullo J. 099 and seconded by Rep. Smith R. 108. Discussion was held on the amendment and the chair asked for a roll call vote which failed 5 to 7. The chair then asked for a roll call vote on the original bill which passed 8 to 5.

Motion to JF HB 5124 was made by Rep. McGee B. 005 and seconded by Rep. Butler L. 072. After discussion was held, the chair asked for a roll call vote which passed 8 to 5.

Motion to JF HB 5125 was made by Rep. McGee B. 005 and seconded by Rep. Gonzalez M. 003. After discussion was held the chair asked for a roll call vote which passed 13 to 0.

Motion for a change of reference to the Planning and Development Committee on HB 5127 was made by Rep. McGee B. 005 and seconded by Rep. Gonzalez M. 003. Discussion was held and then passed by voice vote.

Motion to JF HB 5238 was made by Rep. McGee B. 005 and seconded by Rep. Rose K. 118. After discussion was held and the chair asked for a roll call vote which passed 12 to 0.

Motion to JF HB 5243 was made by Rep. Zullo J. 099 and seconded by Rep. Rose. After discussion was held the chair asked for a roll call vote which passed 12 to 0.

Motion JFS HB 5244 was made by Rep. McGee B. 005 and seconded by Rep. Rose K. 118. After discussion was held the chair asked for a roll call vote which passed 8 to 3.

A motion was duly made and seconded to recess the meeting at 3:08 p.m.
