Rep. Pavalock-D'Amato did we determine if there was a violation of the Constitution in the pending court cases?

Rep. Pavalock-D'Amato is the bill limited to specific types of drugs?

Rep. Scanlon, S. 98 No.

Rep. Pavalock-D'Amato so all medications all prescriptions?

Rep. Scanlon, S. 98 brand name and generic drugs.

Rep. Pavalock-D'Amato and does your answer pertain to all sections?

Sen. Lesser, M. S09 it depends on the section you are referring too. The Canadian importation section does not cover biologics and certain other categories such as controlled substances.

Rep. Pavalock-D'Amato the JFS language that includes a study could you explain that.

Sen. Lesser, M. S09 the Insurance Commissioner will study the impact of capping the annual percentage increase and report back the insurance committee with the results.

Rep. Pavalock-D'Amato thank you that's all the questions I have.

Sen. Lesser, M. S09 no it is looking at the entire issue of insurance for the undocumented population.
