Department of Labor **“UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE MODERNIZATION”** The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is amended in Sections 31-222-9, 31-222-13, 31-235-1, 31-235-22 to 31-235-23, inclusive, 31-235-27, 31-244-1a to 31-244-4a, inclusive, 31-244-7a to 31-244-9a, inclusive, 31-273-2, 31-273-4 to 31-273-5, inclusive, 31-273-8, and amended by repealing Section 31-235-7, 31-235-21, 31-235-24 to 31-235-26, inclusive. (CLJ Notice Date: 3/18/2020, A.G. Approval Date: 5/28/2020 - Bearing a Deadline Date of 8/6/2020).

The above captioned regulation was **LRRC – Rejected Without Prejudice** by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee on 7/30/2020. The action was based on the recommendations of the Legislative Commissioners’ Office. The necessary corrections are outlined in the attached report.

The regulation should be corrected as specified by the Committee, if applicable, approved by the Attorney General for legal sufficiency pursuant to section 4-169 of the Connecticut General Statutes, and then resubmitted to the Legislative Regulation Review Committee with a summary of the revisions listed by paragraph. Pursuant to section 4-170(e) of the Connecticut General Statutes, if it is a mandatory regulation, it must be resubmitted to the committee no later than the first Tuesday of the second month following the regulation’s rejection.
