Notice of Intent to Adopt Regulations

Statutory Authority

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, notice is hereby given that the Labor Commissioner, pursuant to Section 4-8 and 4-167 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, and under the authority of section 31-250 of the General Statutes, proposes to adopt changes to the **Unemployment Insurance (UI) regulations**.

Purpose

The purpose of these regulatory changes is to make technical changes for purposes of the Department's modernization initiative and update work search requirements.

Comment Period

A comment period of not less than thirty (30) days shall begin upon posting of this notice to the eRegulations System website and shall end on **April 18, 2020**. All interested parties who wish to submit comments, data, views, or arguments may do so in writing within thirty (30) days following publication of this notice by submitting comments through the CT eRegulations portal on the Secretary of the State's website, or by emailing or writing to Attorney Rugens at the address below:
