The Committee on Planning and Development reported through SEN. CASSANO of the 4th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF CERTAIN HOUSING IN THE TOWN OF SOUTH WINDSOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of
2 Developmental Services shall conduct a study concerning the
3 establishment of housing units in the town of South Windsor for clients
4 of the Manchester chapter of the Arc of Connecticut. Such study shall
5 include, but not be limited to, an examination of (1) the number of such
6 clients for whom housing may be required, and (2) the ability for such
7 chapter to effectively provide services to such clients.

8 (b) Not later than January 1, 2022, the commissioner shall submit to
9 the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
10 cognizance of matters relating to public health and planning and
11 development, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
12 general statutes, (1) a report on the findings of such study, and (2)
13 recommendations for legislation to address any potential concerns
14 identified by such study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
