AN ACT CONCERNING THE RIGHT TO COUNSEL IN EVICTION PROCEEDINGS, THE VALIDITY OF INLAND WETLANDS PERMITS IN RELATION TO CERTAIN OTHER LAND USE APPROVALS, AND EXTENDING THE TIME OF EXPIRATION OF CERTAIN LAND USE PERMITS.

Explanation

The bill makes technical changes to the right to counsel for eviction proceedings program and does not result in a fiscal impact. The bill also stipulates that certain permits issued by inland wetlands agencies will not take effect until planning or zoning commissions approve land use applications. This is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact as it does not alter permit fees or when permits are issued.
