## ***Explanation***

This bill requires the state building inspector and the Codes and Standards Committee to revise the State Building Code, by January 1, 2022. This revision will require newly constructed or substantially renovated public buildings to provide on each floor level that is open to the public two changing tables with one accessible to women and one accessible to men or at least one accessible to both women and men.

The cost of the baby diaper changing tables would be incorporated into the bid for the construction for state and municipal buildings that fall under the purview of the bill, which is estimated to be minimal.
