AN ACT REQUIRING EMPLOYERS TO RECALL CERTAIN LAID-OFF WORKERS IN ORDER OF SENIORITY.

Explanation

The bill, which requires certain employers meet certain requirements related to recalling certain employees laid off between March 10, 2020, and May 1, 2022, does not result in any fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.

The bill allows aggrieved parties to bring an action before Superior Court over alleged violations, which does not result in any fiscal impact to the Judicial Department. The court system disposes of over 400,000 cases annually and the number of cases is not anticipated to be great enough to require additional resources.

Senate "A" narrows the conditions under which the provisions of the bill apply, which does not result in any fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.

House "A" tightens and makes other changes to various criteria under the bill, which does not result in any fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
