AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE FIRE PREVENTION AND FIRE SAFETY CODES, MEMBERSHIP OF THE CODE TRAINING AND EDUCATION BOARD OF CONTROL, APPOINTMENT OF A TEMPORARY FIRE MARSHAL AND REPORTS FILED AFTER A FIRE, EXPLOSION OR OTHER FIRE EMERGENCY.

Explanation

The bill extends to the Fire Safety Code certain provisions related to fire marshal orders, citations, and penalties under the Fire Prevention Code. In addition, this bill requires the Fire Safety Code to include provisions for smoke detectors and warning equipment that use any power source permitted under the code for certain new residential buildings and other residential buildings installing or replacing equipment. These provisions have no fiscal impact.

The bill also changes the composition of the seven-member Code Training and Education Board of Control. In addition, it makes several technical changes by correcting references of committees and codes relating to fire. These changes have no fiscal impact.
