AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNITY FROM CRIMINAL PROSECUTION FOR A MINOR WHO POSSESSES ALCOHOL WHEN THE MINOR SEEKS EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE TO PREVENT THE DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY OF ANOTHER PERSON.

Explanation

The bill prohibits minors from being charged with possessing alcohol when they make a 9-1-1 call to prevent the death or serious injury of another person. To the extent that these minors are currently being charged, the bill results in potential revenue loss from the fine.
