SUBJECT: VOTE NO on SB 842

I have read all 34 pages of the proposed legislation.

The one day public notice period prior to a Public Hearing is inadequate and disrespectful to citizens, employers, employees, and taxpayers.

The legislation appears to offer quality insurance coverage for employees in an affordable manner to employers but the "stop loss" provisions appear to leave employees at risk to have coverage arbitrarily and unilaterally reduced and/or employers to be at risk to cover losses.

I, therefore, strongly oppose SB 842 and ask that majority and minority party legislators vote "no" on SB 842.
