I am writing to express my grave concern over SB 835, which would limit the ability of crisis pregnancy centers to reach women (and their helpless children) in need. Connecticut is one of the most over-regulated states in the country, and coincidentally, NO ONE REALLY WANTS TO LIVE HERE ANYMORE, as demonstrated by the rate of exodus over the last few years.
