**AN ACT INCREASING ACCESS TO FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS
IN MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH SCHOOL RESTROOMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require local and
- 2 regional boards of education to provide free feminine hygiene products,
- 3 as defined in section 18-69e of the general statutes, in restrooms that are
- 4 accessible to students in each middle school and high school under the
- 5 jurisdiction of such boards.

Statement of Purpose:

To require local and regional boards of education to provide free feminine hygiene products in all middle and high school student restrooms.
